1. Introduction to StorePapers

Welcome to this manual. StorePapers is a component and a plugin developed for Joomla! 1.5. This component arises from the need to save, edit and display publications of a group working efficiently. This component is focused primarily on groups of researchers.

One common problem is that a publication "X" is written by three researchers from the same group, these three researchers want to add this entry in the publication to your personal profile. This makes one publication is having to write several times along the web making it difficult to maintain consistent information for all publications of the research group where they belong. With StorePapers this problem disappears because it only needs to write it once and know where the plugin should display the entries in the publications as they go out on the Web, either through personal profiles of researchers or other parts of the web. If you change an entry in a publication such amendment would affect all profiles.

Besides the above example there are other types of queries and grouping of publications.

StorePapers is based on PHP and MySQL to run properly, **it requires PHP5**. Below are the entities that have been identified for the correct operation.

Design Database StorePapers



An author may have multiple publications and once a publication may have been written by multiple authors (the N - N). While a publication can only belong to a category.

It is mandatory to have at least one category in the database to function properly inserting publications. Not so in the appearance of authors and publications can be inserted and not have associated any author. From the control panel the option of StorePapers see statistics of the authors and categories.

2. Installation

2.1 New installation

To install the plug component and uses the installation tool's own Joomla! found in the administration part.



Within the “**Extensions** → **Install/Uninstall**” select the files to install, remember that only accepts files with the .zip extensions.

Once installed the files "com_storepapers_x.zip" and "plg_storepapers_x.zip" successfully is to enable the plugin. Click on “**Extensions** → **Plugins manager**”.

By default the plugin will StorePapers Unpublished and in a different order. We published to make it available and it is advisable to place the principle of all plugins of type "Content". To do this we introduce into the column "Order" and press the number 1. With that we're done with the plugin.

To view the status of the component clicked "Components → StorePapers" and you should see the control panel.

For this component to function properly must be installed and published the plugin StorePapers.

Include the following code in content article that no space for publications database. For ID's just press "Manager of Authors", "category manager" and "Manager of Publications."

- {storepapersauthorcategory:ID AUTHOR:ID CATEGORY}
- {storepapersauthorcategorypriority:ID AUTHOR:ID CATEGORY: PRIORITY}
- {storepaperscategory:ID CATEGORY}
- {storepapersyearcategory:YEAR:ID CATEGORY}
- {storepaperspublication:ID PUBLICATION}

Optionally you can include an option at the end of each code.

- Option "LIST": There are three possibilities, 1st "NONE", 2nd "NUMBER", 3rd "DEFAULT" or not to put anything. This option modifies the way in which the query is displayed on the website.

Example: {storepaperscategory:ID CATEGORY:LIST:NUMBER}

2.2 Update

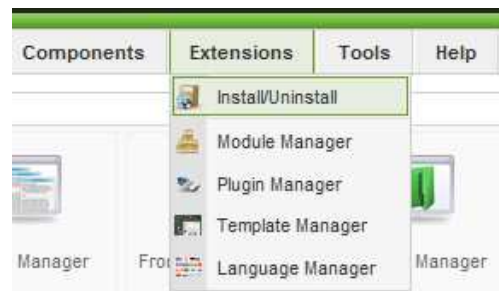
The component update process is easy, just uninstall the component from the menu, it installs the new version and click on the control panel StorePapers. **IMPORTANT!** If you have version 1.1 of the component in Section 2.2.2 outlined the steps you take to get to version 1.2. Once updated to version 1.2 follows the steps 2.2.1 to version 1.2 update to the most current version.

For the plugin does not have to make any step update, simply uninstall and install the latest version of the plugin.

2.2.1 Version 1.2 onwards

To update your version of StorePapers 1.2 to the latest version you must perform the following steps:

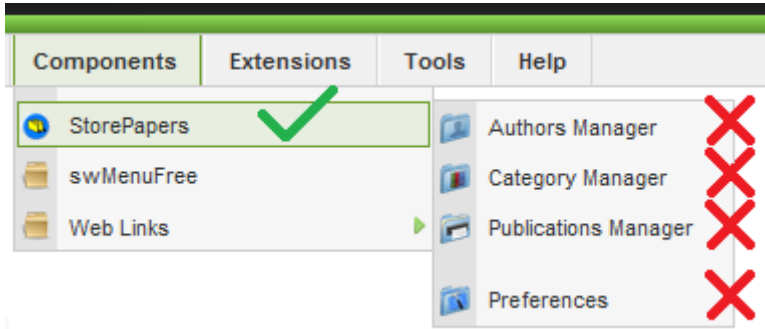
- 1.- Make a backup of your website.
- 2.- StorePapers uninstall the component.

3.- Install the latest version of the component StorePapers.

4.- **To complete the update for the component must click on the icon "StorePapers"** as indicated below. You can't click on any icon from the submenu.




By clicking "StorePapers" forced to update the program once punctured should appear a window update as shown below.

Once this is done we have our StorePapers updated version.

2.2.2 Version 1.1 to Version 1.2

To update your StorePapers version 1.1 to version 1.2 you must perform the following steps:

1.- Make a backup of your website.

2.- You have to delete the file "**http://(site name)/administrator/components/com_storepapers/uninstall.sql**". To delete the file using FTP can if you use a hosting of your website or easier if you have physical access to the server.

3.- Edit the file **http://(site name)/administrator/components/com_storepapers/storepapers_install.xml** and delete the lines from the 19 to 23 inclusive. To edit the file like the previous step, using FTP or physically accessing the server. If you use FTP first download this file, edit it locally using a text editor (be sure you're really blurring the lines of text) and after being amended to raise it again to your website replace it with an existing file.

4.- From the control panel Joomla! of your website, uninstall the component StorePapers Version 1.1.

5.- Install the component StorePapers Updated Version 1.1 to Version 1.2.

6.- Go to control panel StorePapers Version 1.2, to access the necessary changes be made to move from Version 1.1 to Version 1.2.

7.- Need not take any action to update the plugin from Version 1.1 to Version 1.2. Just uninstall the plugin Version 1.1 and install the plugin version 1.2.

3. Component StorePapers

The component makes graphical interface for insertion, retrieval and deletion of items StorePapers. The menu is divided into four main managers. Preferences, Authors Manager, Category Manager and Publications Manager. Each has a toolbar to perform various operations.

The homepage of the component displays the same logo and instructions for use. In the bottom shows the author's name, version, email and the type of license used in the component and the plugin.

3.1 Preferences



In the “Preferences” menu we have the option of modifying the initial year, past and present since start publishing. These values are used when inserting a new publication or when editing. Take-off year for one year beginning (initial), has a maximum (last) and the default (current).

The initial year value must be less than last year and now must lie between these two values.

3.2 Authors Manager



On the menu of “Manager of Authors” We can visualize the discharged authors, each author sets out by the publications that have in each category and the sum of all. In the Status column shows each category the number of publications are published or Unpublished status.

Options to add and edit authors. We can also delete authors.

The options “Publish” and “Unpublish”, are responsible for posting or Unpublish all the publications an author has been involved. If a publication has been written by more than one author and decides “Unpublish” all publications of one of them, the publication by these authors shared Unpublish.

Lastly is the “Statistics”, this option displays the number of publications of an author breakdown by year and compared with the total number of publications. You can also filter the statistics by using the drop-categories. When selecting a specific category automatically updates the information displayed on screen. As summarized in the last row shows the amount of publications that this author participated and the per cent of the total.

3.3 Category Manager



Category Manager

In the menu “Category Manager” can see the categories that are in the system, each category shows the number of publications it contains. In the “Status” column shows how many publications are published or unpublished status.

Options to add and edit categories. We can also delete categories.

The options “Publish” and “Unpublish” are responsible for posting or unpublish all publications containing a category.

Lastly is the “Statistics”, this option displays the number of publications in a breakdown by year and category compared with the total number of publications. As summarized in the last row shows the sum of the publications containing the category and the per cent of the total.

3.4 Publications Manager



Publications Manager

In the menu “Publications Manager”, we can see the publications are in the system, each publication displays the name, status, category, the author(s) who has (have) participated and the priority attached to this (os) author(s).

Options to add and edit publications. We can also delete publications.

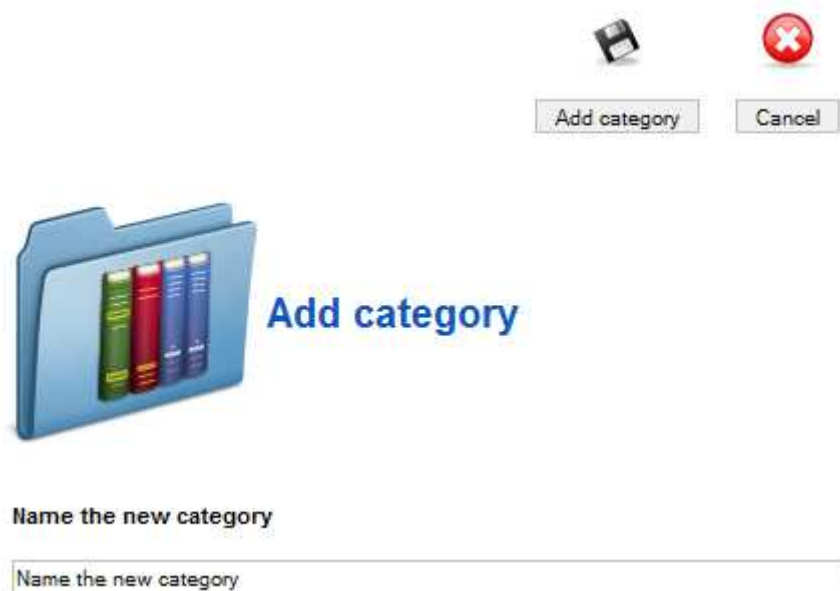
The options “Publish” and “Unpublish”, are responsible for posting or Unpublish the selected publication.

It is possible to filter the publications displayed on screen. You can filter by one or combination of author, category and year.

4. Examples of use

The best way to understand the behavior of this component is a series of examples.

From the control panel StorePapers clicked “**Categories Manager → Add**”. I get a text field to include the name. Our first category is “Articles”.



After inserting this new category we will repeat the process and insert two new categories. “Theses” and “Diploma of Advanced Studies (DEA)”. Already done this from the control panel prick “**Category Manager**” and shows a table with new entries.

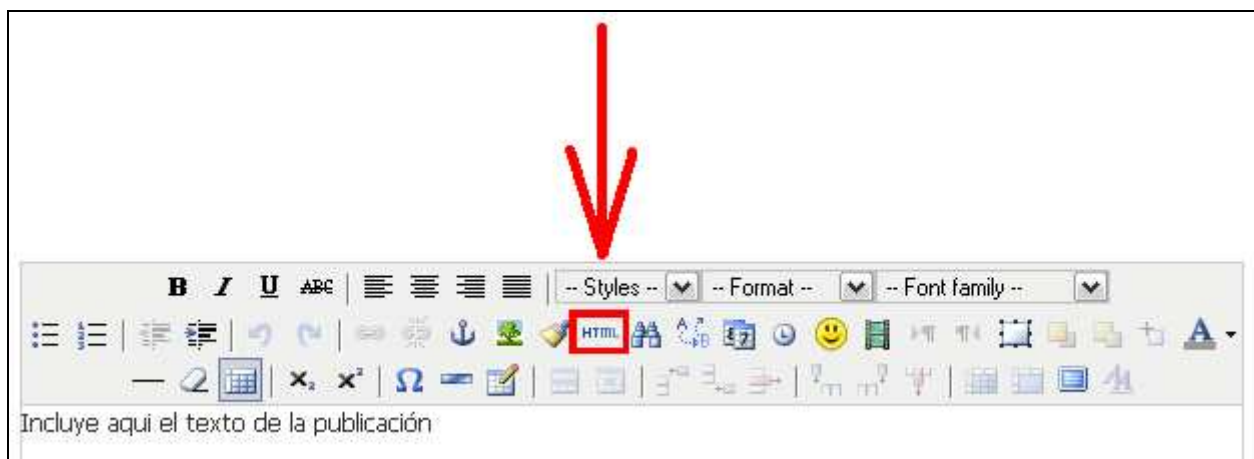

We have 7 fields to complete before you save the publication.

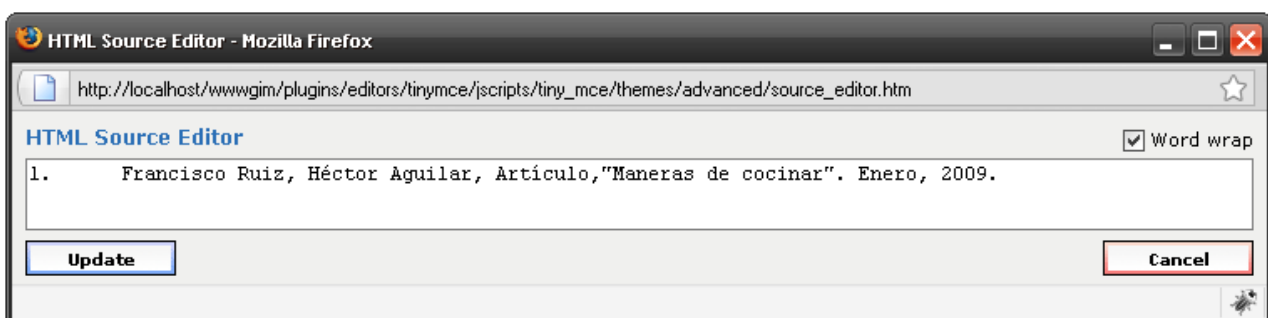
1. Text to display in the query, type the text that appears when the navigator that shows the web.

2. Name of publication, is the name by which we designate this publication.
3. Year and month of publication, select the year and month of publication.
4. Category, select the category to which this publication belongs.
5. Publish, publication status. By default it is published.
6. Authors and directors of PFC. Here you can select one or more authors for this publication, you must hold down the Ctrl button to select multiple authors.
7. Priority of publication, a number is written here that among a range greater than zero and less than or equal to 100. Each author used to give the publication a priority to be shown on your personal profile.

Tip: To insert text in field 1 is copied as quickly as the source of the document with "Ctrl + c" and click on the icon that points below.



Once clicked on this icon displays a pop-up and is in the window where you press "Ctrl + v" to paste the contents of field 1. Once done press update and now if we give him something to format text (bold, italic ...)



Insert publications, each number indicates that is what you should write on the publication insertion window.

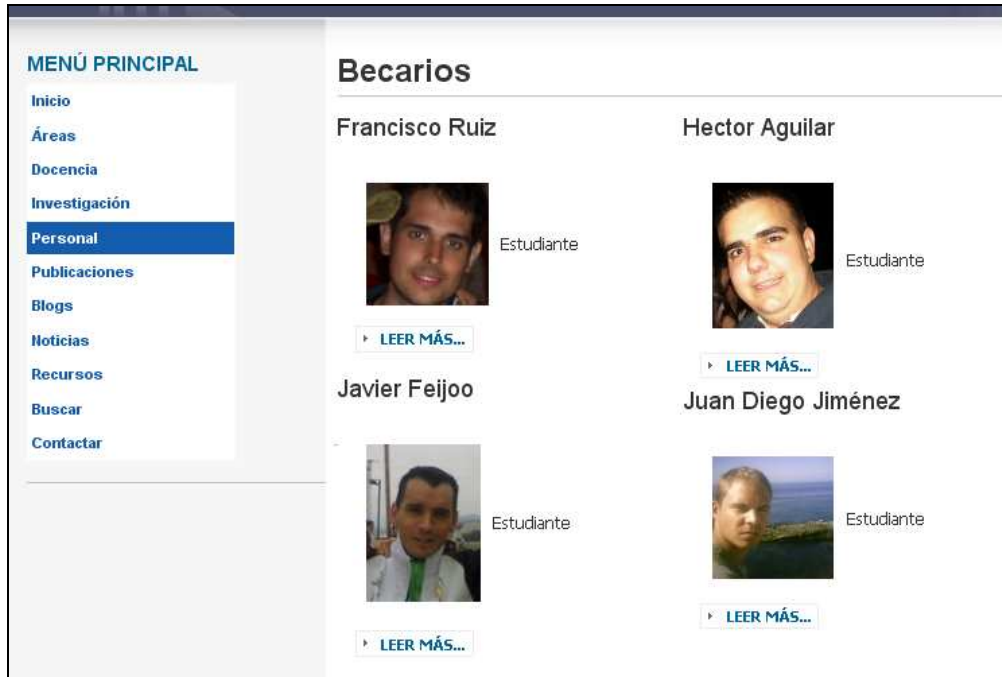

4.1 Include code in Joomla! content items

For this part of the example we use four items of content, one for each author for practice and insert the plugin code StorePapers.



Each query returns codes to display publications on the web. **Show only those publications which are in a state publication.** There are 8 possible types of consultation on StorePapers database. These codes may need identifiers (id). These identifiers are shown in the left column of "Authors Manager", "Category Manager" and "Publications Manager".

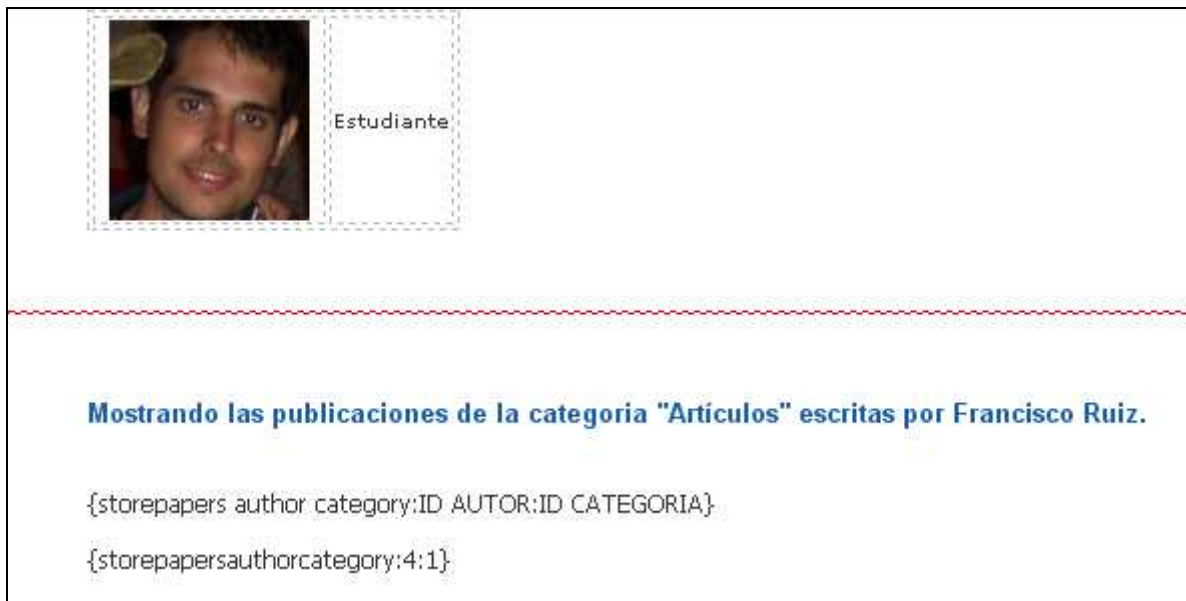
- {storepapersauthorcategory:ID AUTHOR:ID CATEGORY} This code returns all publications of an author and is in a category.
- {storepapersauthorcategorypriority:ID AUTHOR:ID CATEGORY:PRIORITY} This code returns all publications of an author, category and given due priority.
- {storepaperscategory:ID CATEGORY} Return all publications of a category.
- {storepapersyearcategory:ID AÑO:ID CATEGORY } Returns all publications published in a year and a category.
- {storepaperspublication:ID PUBLICACION} Returns a single publication.
- {storepapersauthorpublications: AUTHOR ID} This code returns all publications related to an author. From 1.22. **NEW.**

- {storepapersauthorpublicationspriority: ID AUTHOR: PRIORITY} This code returns all publications related to an author and the required priority. From 1.22. **NEW.**
- {storepaperspublications:} This code returns all the publications that are in the database. From 1.22. **NEW.**

4.1.1 Code 1: “Author, Category”

In profile Francisco Ruiz wrote the code “(storepapersauthorcategory: ID AUTHOR: ID CATEGORY)”. The ID of the author of “Francisco Ruiz” is 4 and the ID of the category “Articles” is 1. The result are all publications ordered by year (most recent to most distant) and by publication name (A - Z).

This is the editing screen of an article (back - end).



And this is the view from the front - end of the website.

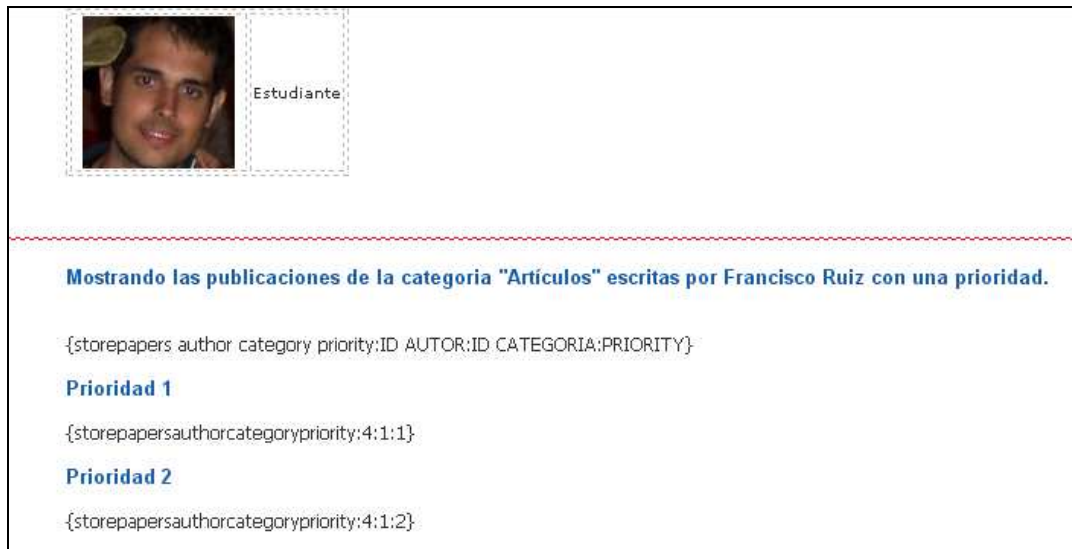


The plugin takes care of removing the code “(storepapersauthorcategory: 4:1)” and show the text of the publications that have the selection criteria defined in the code. In this case we selected the ID of “Francisco Ruiz” (id 4) and the ID of the category “Articles” (id 1).

4.1.2 Code 2: “Author, Category, Priority”

In profile Francisco Ruiz wrote the code “(storepapersauthorcategorypriority: ID AUTHOR: ID CATEGORY: PRIORITY)”. The identifiers are the same as the previous code. Before this I modified the publication “Maneras de Cocinas” in field 7 priority of publication have changed the 1 by a 2 in the name of “Francisco Ruiz”.

And this is the view from the front - end of the website.




Publications are now displayed according to the number indicated in field 7 priority of publication. If “Francisco Ruiz” publications have different priority 1 and 2 do not show because I have only the ID of priority 1 and 2.

4.1.3 Code 3: "Category"

This code displays on screen all publications that are in a category. To do this we write the code "{storepapers category:ID CATEGORIA}". The unique identifier that we use is the category. The result are all publications ordered by year (most recent to most distant) and by publication name (A - Z).



This code displays on screen all publications that are in a category in a particular year. The code is “(storepapersyearcategory: ID YEAR: ID CATEGORIA)”. We use the class identifier and the year for which we want to filter. The result are all publications ordered by publication name (A - Z).



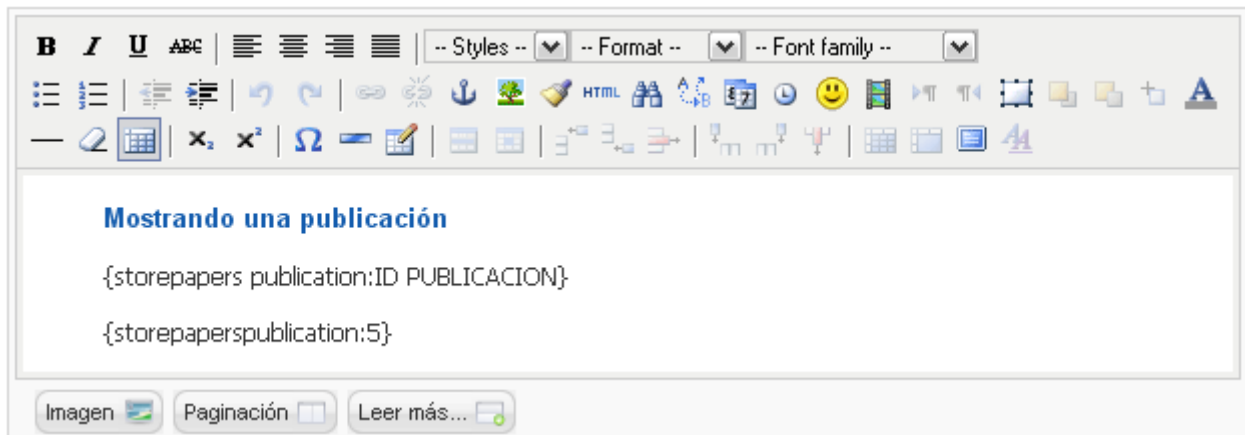

The plugin takes care of removing the code “(storepapersauthorpublications:4)” and show the text of the publications that have the selection criteria defined in the code. In this case we selected the ID of “Francisco Ruiz” (id 4).

4.1.7 Code 7: “Author, Publications, Priority”. **NEW**

The profile of Francisco Ruiz wrote the code "{storepapersauthorpublicationspriority: ID AUTHOR: PRIORITY}". Identifiers are the same as in previous codes. The result is all the publications that the author has participated Francisco Ruiz and also match the value of priority.

This code is similar to the code 4.1.2.

4.1.8 Code 8: “Publications”. **NEW**

This code returns all publications that are in the database. You do not need identifiers.

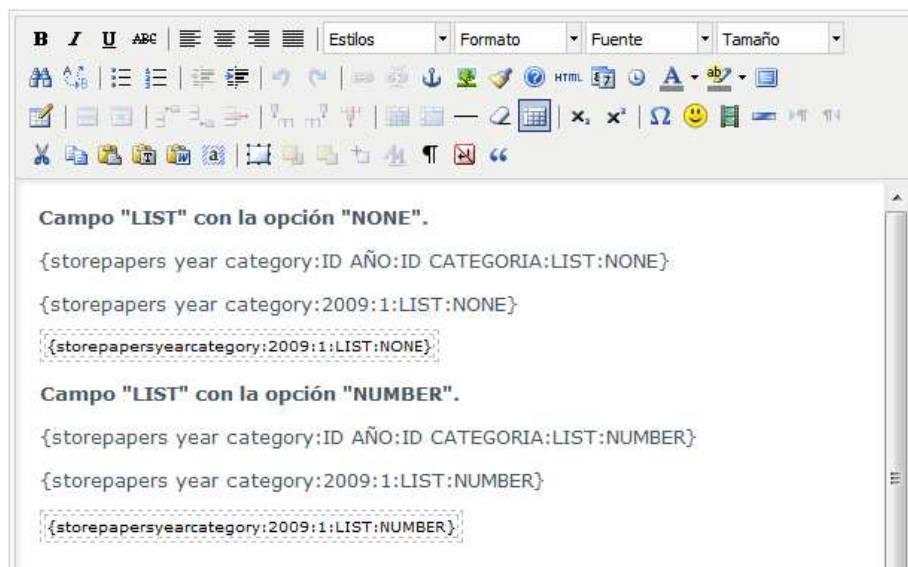
4.2 Optional fields include codes

StorePapers Since version 1.2, includes the possibility that each code described above has one or more optional fields. Are described below.

4.2.1 Option: “LIST”

The “LIST” provides three different ways to show the query in the page, numbering, bullets or anything. The “LIST” works with any of the codes seen before.

Include “LIST” and then: “NONE”, “NUMBER”, “DEFAULT” or not to put anything.

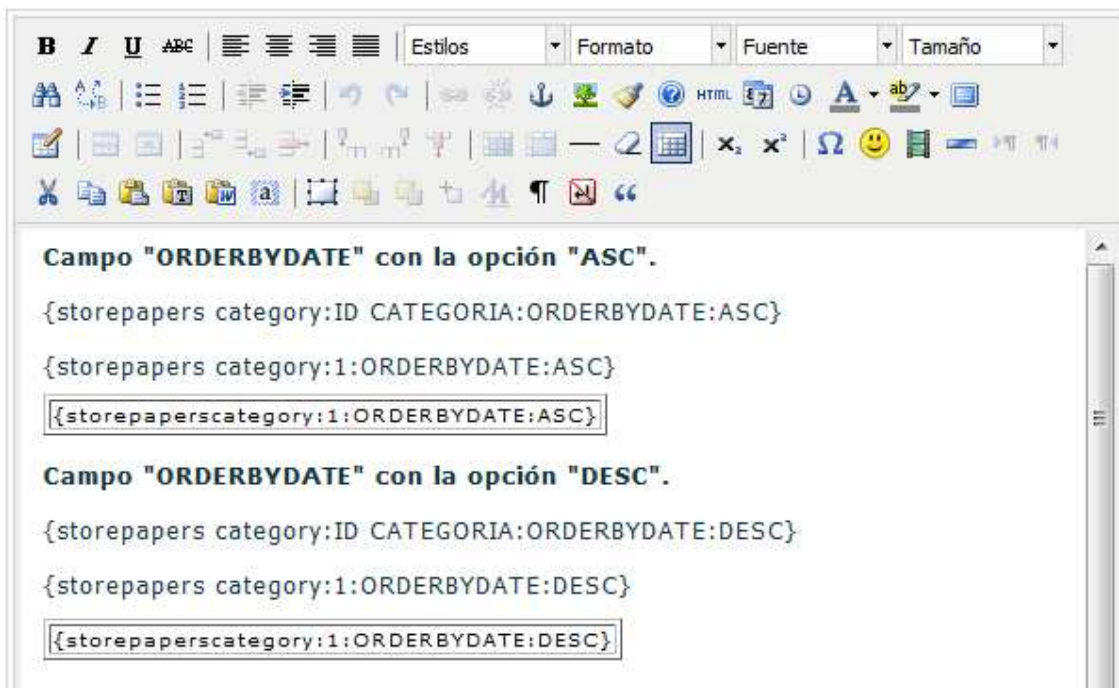

4.2.2 Option: "ORDERBYDATE"

The "ORDERBYDATE"(available since version 1.22) provides two different ways to show the query by date of publication. The "ASC" returns publications in ascending order, first oldest depending on the year and month. The "DESC" returns the earliest publication first, according to year but the month following the first order of January and late December. The "ORDERBYDATE" works with any of the codes seen before.

Include "ORDERBYDATE" and then: "ASC", "DESC" or not to put anything.

5. Consequences of deletion

The component from the administration has options to remove “Authors”, “Categories” and “Publications”. The following describes what happens when you delete one of these options.

1. **Erasing Authors:** the author is erased from the database and all links between the author and his publications. The participating publications where this author are **NOT** deleted.
2. **Deletion of categories:** the category is deleted from the database of **ALL** publications that are related to this category, plus links are also removed from them with the authors.
3. **Publications Clearing:** This deletes the selected publication in the database with links between this publication and authors.

6. Uninstalling

Within the “**Extensions → Install/Uninstall**” and select the component to uninstall the plugin StorePapers. Version 1.2 and subsequent component **NOT DELETED** StorePapers tables forming the database and you have to delete manually.

The tables are used StorePapers identified with “# __storepapers_nametable”, just select the tables that contain the word “_storepapers_” and then “Delete Table” for a complete uninstall StorePapers.

Version 1.1 of the component automatically **ERASES** the tables in the database.

7. Conclusions

I hope this guide has served its purpose which is not another to help understand the operation of STOREPAPERS.

Any suggestions, criticisms and opinions will be welcome and I will consider for future versions of this component.

Some have thought that future changes are:

- Debug faults that are in this version.
- Include support for more languages.
- Improve and refine the graphical interface.
- To improve the statistics.
- Add a module so that visitors can make inquiries from the Front - End.

- The component is multilingual and is translated in Spanish and English languages.
- The plugin accepts optional fields "LIST".
- Improved overall code now uses more code in JavaScript.
- Added the option to view statistics on authors and manager in the manager category.
